Grapes:	Grape blend of at least three (3) of the following grape varieties: cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc, carmenère, petit verdot and malbec. No grape variety may be more than 70%. No other grape varieties may be included in the grape blend.
Vintage:	2021 or older
